


Senator **John McCain's** plan for Social Security is simple – **and dangerous.**

What's wrong with Senator **John McCain** and his plan to risk our Social Security retirement funds in the stock market?

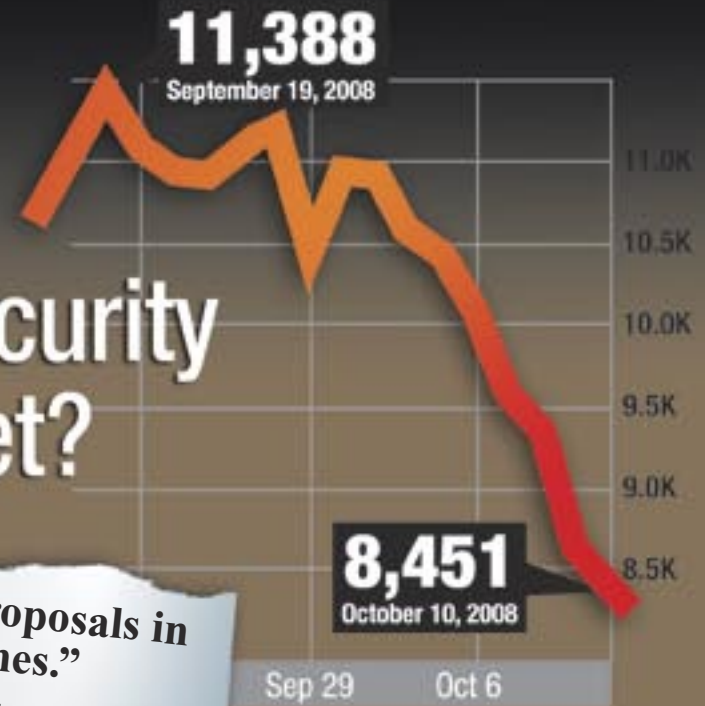
Even the Wall Street Journal wants to know:
